

Community Related Activities

- Listen to the "music" animals, birds & bugs make during the day & then during the night- what sounds are different?
- Make someone's day better with music.
- Make a list of how rocks are important to our environment.
- Listen to music while you clean up a park or your neighborhood.
- Brush your teeth with the water off to a 2 minute long song.
- Make a list of how many colors of rocks you see along the river?
- Visit a place new to you; is there music? Why or why not?
- Make a list of some ways rocks are being used in our county.
- Write the sounds you hear in a journal daily for 1 week. Are there differences each day?
- Go to a community festival or event. Is there music?
- Help with household chores- play music to make it more fun.
- Learn about the Soil & Water Department- is there a volunteer opportunity for you?

POETRY IN MOTION

S.T.E.A.M. Related Activities

- Play on the Chrome Music Lab.
- Try watching a movie or show without the music. How does that affect your view of it?
- Listen to a playlist of your favorite tunes while trying not to move anything. How long did you last? Try it on a friend.
- What is an ear worm? Tell someone about it & give them an example of one that affects you.
- Play different types of music near a glass of water. Which music creates the most vibration? Why? - find out at the library.
- Use junk to build your own musical instrument. Name it & learn to play a song on it.
- Conduct a sound experiment- check your library for ideas.
- Find 5 everyday objects that have no musical purpose, but can be used that way.
- Journal about how different types of music make you feel.
- What is synesthesia? What are photisms?
- Find 3 different types of rock indigenous to our area.
- How is a fossil formed?

READING ROCKSTAR

Library, Reading & Writing Related Activities

- Read 20 minutes a day for a week.
- Attend 2 library events.
- Read a book with a friend & talk about how it made you each feel.
- Create a playlist for a book you have read.
- Check out 3 books about music or musicians from your library.
- Get to know your librarian's "rock style" -hint: ask interview type questions.
- Complete a passive activity at the library-ask the librarian.
- Check out 3 books about rocks.
- Read a book you wouldn't normally choose.
- Find something you & your librarian have in common. Perhaps a favorite song?
- Sing your favorite children's rhyme or story out loud as if it were a rock song.
- Create lyrics to your favorite song that are the opposite of the song's actual lyrics.
- Read to your favorite pet/stuffed animal, then sing to it.

Personal Growth & Health Related Activities

- Dance & sing to a favorite song.
- Sing or share a song with your favorite person.
- Use your favorite songs to create a personal exercise routine.
- Maintain a dance exercise routine 4 days within 1 week.
- Don't lose your cool for 3 days in a row.
- Play "Just Dance" or "Rock Band" (If you don't have them, check your library for times it is available to play there.)
- Learn 5 things about your birthstone.
- Listen for half an hour to a style of music you have never heard before.
- Create your own dance move & give it a name (like the dab).
- Play Spontaneous (available at your library) or other musical games with friends or family.
- Listen to a song; then draw a picture to describe it's feeling.
- Ask someone older, like a parent or grandparent about the music of their generation.
- Create a musical collage that defines you.
