
Art in the Park is now seeking vendors!

At the library's author talks, workshops, and book clubs, community members can connect with fellow enthusiasts and local experts while building relationships that will last a lifetime.


Thank you to the donor for this beautiful addition to the library grounds. We hope it inspires a bit of childlike wonder as you walk into DPL!


