FOCUS

- Pay attention the the tool you are currently using, be aware of any sharp edges, pinching points or hot surfaces.
 - Running and horseplay are dangerous around MakerSpace equipment.

KEEP CLEAR

- Keep your hands, clothing, and other belongings clear of MakerSpace equipment. Secure anything that may be a potential hazard.

RESPECT EQUIPMENT

- Do not pull on cords or attempt to move heavy equipment.
 - Use appropriate setting for materials being used on MakerSpace equipment, if you are unsure ask the attending if materials can be used and what settings are required.

BE AWARE

- Please alert the MakerSpace attendant if any equipment/tools appears broken or damaged.
 - If you become injured let the MakerSpace attendant know. There is a first aid kit available.

CHOOSE SAFE

- Wear appropriate safety devices (safety glasses, apron, gloves, mask, etc.) when needed.
- Use tools properly to avoid unnecessary risk of damage or personal injury.
- Children under the age of 10 should always work with adult supervision (a parent or guardian outside of programming time).
