

The Defiance Public Library System Board of Trustees welcomes Jenny Derringer, who was sworn in at the board's July 30 meeting.

Derringer will finish the term of former Board President Laura Rath-Connor, which extends to Dec. 31, 2027. Dennis Sobecki is the current board president.

Derringer spent 36 years working for the Defiance Crescent-News, serving as a photographer, reporter, and education editor, among other roles. She retired in 2021.



DPL NOW A SIGNUP LOCATION FOR THE 'OHIO LIBRARY FOR THE BLIND & PRINT DISABLED' PROGRAM

Defiance Public Library is now a signup location for the Ohio Library for the Blind and Print Disabled (OLBPD). The OLBPD—a partnership between the State Library of Ohio, Cleveland Public Library, and the National Library Service for the Blind and Print Disabled—administers a free library program of audio and braille reading materials circulated to eligible borrowers throughout the state by postage–free mail or download.

Those with a visual disability who meet certain qualifications are eligible to receive a free audio player and cartridge(s) (up to three cartridges can be checked out at a time) loaded with up to 24 books per cartridge. Those with physical, reading, or other disabilities may choose to have their application certified by a medical professional to access additional resources and services.

By law, preference in lending reading materials and equipment is given to honorably discharged veterans of the United States military. New Online Resource: Educate Station

Defiance Public Library System cardholders now have access to a new online resource called Educate Station. Educate Station is a digital program developed by educators with homeschooling families and teachers in mind. It offers a full curriculum for grades pre-K through fifth, presented in a recommended learning sequence of printable packets. Subjects of study include English language arts, math, science, social studies, socialemotional learning and art.


