
NEW MATERIALS AT DPLS



NEW RESOURCE: LEARN ONLINE WITH CURRICULUM FROM EDUCATE STATION

Teachers, homeschooling families, or anyone looking for learn-from-home opportunities for kids now have a new resource at their fingertips courtesy of Defiance Public Library System (DPLS).

DPLS cardholders now have access to Educate Station, a digital/online resource offering full curriculums for grades pre-K through 5th, presented in a recommended learning sequence of printable packets.

Educate Station content is created by a team of experienced educators from across the United States, bringing vast subject-matter expertise, teaching credentials, and many years of experience as classroom teachers and curriculum developers. Subjects available include English language arts, math, science, social studies, social-emotional learning, and art.

FRIENDS OF DPL FALL BOOK SALE



Read, draw, and get inspired this fall with the return of our annual reading and art challenges for grades 6-12, both taking place Oct. 1-31.






In other news...
