








WORTHINGTON CEMETERY GETS HISTORICAL MARKER

We are honored to share that Worthington's Cemetery — Defiance County's only known historic Black cemetery — now has an official Ohio Historical Marker. It was installed Oct. 17 at the site, located in Highland Township, on Bowman Road, about 1/4 mile east of Ohio 15.

This meaningful recognition was made possible through the collaboration of our library and dedicated community partners. We extend our sincere thanks to everyone who contributed their time, research, and support to make this a reality. A formal dedication event will be held at the site in the spring.






In other news...
