

Join us at Defiance Public Library for stories, songs, rhymes, and fun during Winter Storytime/Read, Rhyme, & Romp.



FREE INFO SESSION: SECURE ACT 2.0 & RETIREMENT



Michael Sebring of Postema Insurance and Investments will visit Defiance Public Library, 320 Fort Street, on January 15 from 10:30–11:30AM to present a free informational session on the SECURE Act 2.0 and its impact on retirement accounts.

The SECURE Act 2.0 (officially part of the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023) is a major U.S. retirement savings law that builds on the original SECURE Act of 2019 by updating and expanding rules affecting 401(k)s, IRAs, and other retirement plans.

This session is open to all adults, and no registration is needed.
